



SCHOOLS OF LOGIC AND RHETORIC *Uniforms*

Students are required to purchase one set of the formal uniform pieces; all other pieces are optional. Unless otherwise noted, all uniform pieces must be purchased from Land's End, Educational Outfitters, or Tommy Hilfiger.

As stated in the handbook, Eagle Ridge Academy maintains an official standard of dress, complete with a school uniform that must be worn every day in order to: encourage students to think of their attire as an aspect of their work, eliminate self-consciousness and social competition, and foster a sense of identity. The uniform is to be worn at all times during the school day. Formal uniform is required on formal uniform days, on specified field trips, and on special occasions.

Formal Dress Requirements (may be worn daily):

<p>Top Options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shirt: long-sleeved white Oxford (tucked in) or white pinpoint feminine fit blouse (logo optional) <i>Note: Polo or Oxford must be worn, even if wearing a sweater, sweatshirt, or fleece. All undershirts must be plain white.</i> • Tie: burgundy (required with Oxford shirt) • Optional formal dress pieces: <i>White Oxford shirt or white pinpoint feminine fit blouse must be worn under these items:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Cardigan: burgundy (logo optional) ○ V-neck sweater: burgundy (logo optional) ○ Sweater vest: burgundy (logo optional) 	<p>Religious Headwear Options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On formal dress days and during school performances, religious headwear must be solid black, gray, white, or burgundy with no pattern or adornment. <p><i>*Note: Hats and caps may not be worn during the school day as they are not considered part of the school uniform.</i></p>
<p>Bottom Options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pants: khaki or gray with black or brown leather belt with standard buckle (belt can be purchased anywhere) • Skirt: plaid or gray (hemmed no higher than 3" above the knee); black or gray long skirt option 	<p>Footwear Options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Socks: black, white, or gray (solid color with no pattern); if visible, ankle or knee high* • Tights: black, white, gray, or burgundy (solid color with no pattern) <i>Note: Leggings are not part of the formal dress uniform.*</i> • Shoes: brown or black dress shoes* <p><i>*Headwear, socks, tights, and shoes may be purchased anywhere.</i></p>

Casual Uniform Pieces (if not wearing formal dress):

<p>Top Options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Polo: white or burgundy; banded or not; short- or long-sleeved (logo optional) • Crew-neck sweatshirt with logo: burgundy • Sweater or sweatshirt • Fleece vest with logo: burgundy • Fleece jacket with logo: black <p><i>Note: Undershirts can be either black, gray, or white under casual pieces</i></p>	<p>Religious Headwear Options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students may wear any color, unadorned, religious headwear. On formal dress days and during school performances, religious headwear must be of school colors.* • If wearing an abaya, it must be school colors. <p><i>Note: Hats, caps, and durags may not be worn during the school day as they are not considered part of the school uniform.</i></p>
<p>Bottom Options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Khaki or gray shorts or pants with black or brown leather belt with standard buckle; plaid/gray/black skirt <p><i>Note: Non-banded shirts must be tucked in at all times and belt must be worn.</i></p>	<p>Footwear Options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leggings and tights: black, white, gray, or burgundy (solid color with no pattern)* • Socks: may be any color if ankle length or shorter* • Shoes: tennis shoes, flats* <p><i>*Headwear, socks, tights, and shoes may be purchased anywhere.</i></p>

**Long-sleeved shirts may not be worn under the short-sleeved uniform pieces.*

**Only uniform sweaters and fleeces are allowed to be worn as outer layers during the school day.*

**For physical education, the uniform can be found on the teacher's syllabus.*

Eagle Ridge Academy does not recognize the following as appropriate school day footwear: backless or open-toed styles including but not limited to: flip flops, sandals, Crocs, Uggs, slides, tall boots, snow or rain boots, platform shoes, roller skate shoes, slippers, or shoes designated as unsafe by the teacher. For safety, the heel height must not exceed one inch.

Hair, Makeup, and Accessories should be professional, discreet, and modest. In general, a student's hair, makeup, and accessories should be consistent with the professionalism of the Academy's uniform. Hair may be any color. Accessories must be black, gray, white, or burgundy (solid color with no pattern or adornment except uniform plaid).

DEFINITIONS:

Tights – skintight knit hose that covers the waist, legs, and feet

Leggings – fitted stretch pants that do not cover the feet (sweatpants are not allowed)

Banded – band of fabric around the bottom of the shirt so the shirt can be folded over without being tucked in

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
